

## Back To Eden Gardening



- Find a source for woodchips, compost & cardboard/newspaper.
  Good sources for chips: tree services, power companies, getchipdrop.com. Good source for cardboard: recycle bins behind strip malls and restaurants.
- Lay down cardboard or 3-4 layers of paper.
- Apply 3-4 inches of organic compost or composted manure.
- Add 3-4 inches of woodchips or other available mulch.

- Add a 1-2 inch layer (do not till in) of composted chicken or horse manure on top of your garden.
- When planting seeds and starts, push aside woodchips and plant in the soil. Always water after planting.
- You may need to fertilize the first few years. Fish emulsion is a great option.
- Only water as needed. You don't need to water if the compost beneath the woodchips is damp.
- In the fall, re-apply a layer of compost and woodchips as needed.
